## About IIMC

IIMC operates from its headquarters in New Delhi and five regional campuses across India, including the **Dhenkanal campus** in Odisha, which was set up in **1993** to cater to the Eastern region's media education needs.

## About IIMC: Dhenkanal Campus

IIMC, Dhenkanal is the **Eastern Regional Campus** and **2<sup>nd</sup> oldest campus** of IIMC, situated amidst the lush green hills of *Paniohala*. ## Programme Overview

The curriculum is designed to cater to the needs of **print, electronic, and digital media** with an emphasis on **news reporting, news writing, translation, feature writing, research, TV and Radio script writing and media ethics**.

**Total seats: 30 (Reservations for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwD)**

**(General: 12, SC: 5, ST: 2, OBC: 8 and EWS: 3 = 30 Seats)**

## Eligibility Criteria for admission

- **Educational Qualification:** Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university. Final-year students can also apply, subject to submission of final mark sheets by **30th September 2026**.

- **Age Limit (as on 1st August 2026):**
  - General Category: Born on or after **1st August 2001** (Maximum 25 years)
  - OBC: Born on or after **1st August 1998** (Maximum 28 years)
  - SC/ST/PwD: Born on or after **1st August 1996** (Maximum 30 years)

### **Admission Process**

Admission to the PG Diploma in Odia Journalism will be based on an **Entrance Examination**.

The examination will assess the candidate's:

- Language proficiency in Odia
- General knowledge and current affairs
- Writing skills
- Aptitude for journalism

3. The applicant should fill the form in his/her own handwriting and in English or Odia
4. Candidate should paste his/her recent passport photograph on the application form and sign across it.
5. **Eligibility:** Indian nationals possessing a Bachelor's Degree awarded by a recognized university are eligible to apply. Students who have appeared / are appearing for Final year/semester examination of their Bachelor's Degree are also eligible to apply. If selected, their admission will be subject to their producing at least a Provisional Marks Sheet /Certificate in original from their college / university latest by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025, (extendable in genuine cases after ascertaining the reasons). **On completion of the course, the Diploma will be awarded only if the Original Degree Certificate is produced for verification at Head office.**
6. **Date of Birth:** General Category candidates should be born on 1.8.2001 or later (maximum 25 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2026). For SC/ST/Differently abled candidates, the date of birth should be 1.8.1996 or later (maximum 30 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2026). For OBC category, date of birth should be 1.8.1998 or later (28 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2026).
