4. Candidates can also submit the duly filled hard copy of application form at the office of the Kottayam campus directly.
5. Eligibility: Indian nationals possessing a Bachelor's Degree/ Master's Degree/ Professional Degree awarded by a recognized university are eligible to apply. Candidates who have appeared / are appearing for Final year/semester examination of their final year/semester examination of their Bachelor's Degree are also eligible to apply. However if selected, their admission will be provisional and subject to their submission of at least a Provisional Mark Sheet/Certificate in original from their college / university on or before 30th September 2026, (extendable in genuine cases upon verification). On completion of the course, the Diploma will be awarded only upon submission and verification of the original degree certificate at IIMC office.
6. Date of Birth: General Category candidates should be born on 01.08.2001 or later (maximum 25 years as on 01 August 2026). For SC/ST/Differently abled candidates, the date of birth should be 01.08.1996 or later (maximum 30 years as on 1 August, 2026). For OBC category, date of birth should be 01.08.1998 or later (28 years as on 1 August, 2026).
7. The last date for submitting the filled in application is 08th May 2026. 1. About IIMC

4.1 Admission Process

Entrance Test: Written examination on **23 May 2026 at Kottayam campus from 11.00 am – 2.00 pm.**

Eligibility: Bachelor's degree (final-year students can apply)

Age Limit (as on 1 Aug 2026):

- General: ≤25 years
- OBC: ≤28 years
- SC/ST/PwD: ≤30 years
