# **Important Information for Newly Admitted Students**

Dear Students,

Greetings from the Indian Institute of Mass Communication, Aizawl.

We extend our heartfelt congratulations on your successful admission to the **Post Graduate Diploma in English Journalism** and the **Master of Arts in New Media of Communication** programmes for the academic year 2025–26. We are pleased to welcome you to the IIMC Campus and look forward to your active participation in the academic and co-curricular activities here.

To facilitate a smooth transition and help you prepare for your arrival, please take note of the following essential details regarding accommodation, fee structure, travel guidance, and other arrangements.

#### **Hostel Accommodation**

#### 1. Allotment Criteria:

Hostel seat allotment will be done strictly on a first-come, first-served basis.

#### 2. Bed Availability:

- 24 beds reserved for female students
- 12 beds reserved for male students

Allotments will be made subject to availability at the time of application.

Room allotment will begin only after the successful verification of student documents.

#### 3. Hostel Room Fees

- First Instalment:
  - o Single Room with attached bathroom: ₹23,000
  - o Single Room (Common Bathroom): ₹21,000
  - o Double Sharing Room (Common Bathroom): ₹13,500

\*An amount of Rs 5000 will have to be deposited as Security Deposit: This amount will be refunded upon vacating the room, subject to the clearance of all dues and the issuance of a No Objection Certificate (NOC).

#### • Second Instalment:

o Single Room with attached bathroom: ₹19,000

o **Single Room**: ₹17,000

o **Double Sharing Room**: ₹10,500

The total **Hostel Fee for the Academic Year 2025–26** is to be paid in **two instalments** and is valid for stay up to **30th June 2026**. The **first instalment** is to be paid at the time of **hostel allotment**, and the **second instalment** will be collected in **January 2026** (**by 10th January**). Students who plan to vacate the hostel on or before **30th April 2026** may opt to pay only **80% of the second instalment**. However, if they do not vacate by **30th April** and continue to stay beyond this date, the **remaining 20%** of the second instalment must be paid separately or will be **adjusted from their security deposit**. Please note that **hostel fees, once paid, will not be refunded under any circumstances**.

# **Canteen Charges (Mandatory)**

All students residing in the hostel are required to dine in the hostel canteen, as there are no dining options available on or nearby the campus.

- **Initial payment:** ₹25,000 (for 5 months at ₹5,000/month), to be paid at the time of hostel allotment\*
- Subsequent payments: ₹5,000/month, payable by the first week of each month

Payment to be done after the verification of all the documents

\*Note: Students are encouraged to pay the full five-month mess fee in advance. However, a minimum payment for three months is permissible, with the remaining amount to be paid by the 7th of each subsequent month.

# **Reporting and Commencement of Session**

The academic session is scheduled to commence on **5th August 2025**, with **document verification** to be carried out on the same day and the next day. Students are therefore advised to arrive in Aizawl **one or two days in advance** to allow sufficient time to settle in and familiarize themselves with the new environment.

# **Travel Information – Reaching Aizawl**

#### By Air (Recommended):

- Nearest Airport: Lengpui Airport, Aizawl (approximately 35 km from the city)
- Flight Connectivity: Regular flights from Guwahati, Kolkata, and Imphal
- Transport from Airport to Campus:
  - o Local taxis: ₹1,500–2,000
  - o Rental cars: ₹2,000–3,000
  - o Shared minibuses (up to the city): ₹500 per person (For minibus assistance, contact: 8731914250 / 9862506386)

Note: Taxis are available from the city to the campus (approx. fair is about ₹700-1000)

#### By Road:

- Aizawl is accessible from **Silchar (Assam)** by road (6–8 hours by Sumo).
  - o Approx. sumo fare is ₹600
- Regular buses and shared sumos operate from Guwahati as well.
- **Note:** There is no direct railway service to Aizawl yet. The nearest rail station is **Bairabi, Kolasib**, located approximately 125 km away, followed by road transport (Sumo) to Aizawl City.
  - o Approx. Sumo fare is ₹450

# Important Note for All Students and Their Parents/Guardians

Upon arrival in Aizawl, all students are required to **apply for the Inner Line Permit (ILP)** as mandated by the **Government of Mizoram**. This is a mandatory requirement for all non-residents entering the state. **Parents or guardians accompanying the students** must also complete the same. Once the students are given their Identity cards, this will not be required.

- If you are arriving by air, the ILP can be obtained at the airport itself.
- If you are **coming by road**, the ILP can be done **on the way at the check post**.
